
This year's theme is "God Has a Plan for His People".

The Order was organized in 1867 by two former slaves, Annetta M. Lane of Norfolk, VA, and Harriett R. Taylor of Hampton, VA. It is a Christian fraternal benevolent organization managed predominately by black women. The membership spans from Georgia to Maryland. The Order was incorpo-

The entire history of the organization displays a record of providing shelter and service to people who are unable to care for themselves. In 1897, the

On March 24, 1994, HUD awarded a \$2,736,000.00 grant to The Order to build a 48 housing unit for the elderly in Rocky-Mount, NC. It was named the Bullock-McLeod Apartments. HUD has also awarded 2 other grants to build the Annetta M. Lane Apartments in Norfolk, Va, (40 units) and the

The Order has provided services to the minority community of the Southeastern United States on a continuous basis. The services have taken many different forms over the past centuries and have addressed community needs appropriate to the times. The Order has supported Christianity and mission

The Order's Headquarters is located in Norfolk, VA. It serves as a clearinghouse for funds raised by members and distributes them to organizations

whose goals and purposes match their own; such as the United Negro College Fund, Sickle Cell Anemia Research Fund, Special Olympics, St. Jude

Children's Research Hospital, Shaw University Divinity School, Virginia Union University, Lost Boys of Sudan and many other charitable organizations. The

the Corporation became popularly known by its present name and on June 28, 1912, a charter amendment was granted changing the name. The United

United Order of Tents, Southern District No. 1 established a sixteen (16) bed home for adults. It was named Rest Haven Home for Adults. The home was operated with a hands on approach by management and Tent Sisters. The home was primarily set up for their members as a haven for their sisters without

family members to care for them when they reached their golden age. However, the number of sisters that needed this service was so few that the home was opened to men and women not of The Order. The home operated for 105 years being subsidized by annual contributions given by the Tent Sisters and
